Policy Acknowledgment

The Tucson Nihongo Cafe is a program created and run by volunteer members in Tucson and Anjo City, Aichi, Japan, in collaboration with the Tucson Japanese School. The program executives reserve the right to refuse participation to anyone. Noncompliance with the policies below may result in removal from the program.

Policies

- Participants must register for the program in advance and provide the information requested in the registration form.
- Appropriate attire must be worn at all times.
- Appropriate language must be used at all times, whether in Japanese or English. Foul language or inappropriate subjects of conversation may result in removal from the program.
- Japanese should be spoken to the best of each participant's ability. While some English clarification or explanation may be used as needed, Japanese conversation should predominate.
- No alcoholic beverages or smoking are permitted during the session. Participants who are suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave and may be refused participation in future sessions.

Policy on Minor Participants

- For the purposes of this program, participants under 18 years of age are considered minors. Minor participants may join only with prior consent from a parent or legal guardian.
- To help maintain a safe online environment, minor participants will not be placed in one-on-one breakout rooms with adult participants. When minors are present, breakout room assignments will be managed by the host or program staff.
- Participants may not exchange personal contact information during or through the program. This includes phone numbers, personal email addresses, home addresses, social media accounts, messaging app IDs, or other private contact details.
- When minors participate, the host or designated staff may monitor breakout rooms and may enter, move, or close rooms as needed. The host may also intervene in conversations or end a participant's session if necessary to maintain safety, appropriateness, and respect within the program.
- By joining the program, participants and, where applicable, parents or legal guardians acknowledge and agree to these procedures.
